

Haslington Nursery aims to provide the highest standard in care and education, where children are inspired to learn and develop.

We aim to provide a safe, secure, stimulating and nurturing environment, whilst working in partnership with parents and carers to help children learn, play and develop.

We feel that when children are relaxed, safe, valued and having fun, it builds their confidence and develops independence - making them happier to learn and paving the way for a seamless transition from childcare to education within our primary school.

By working together we can support the development of your child by sharing information about your child's needs, interests and progress. We work within the Early Years Foundation Stage curriculum in order to provide exciting opportunities to encourage the children to learn through play.

Payment and Fees

The fees are £28.00 for all day (for 3–4-year-olds) and £30.00 for all day (for 2 year olds). An invoice will be emailed to the bill payer at the start of each half term. Funded places are available for 2, 3 and 4 year olds. Contact school for more information.

Key Person

When each child begins Nursery they will be assigned a key person. This is often the person they form a bond with. Your child's key person will keep individual records of their progress. These are confidential and parent's input is essential to help track their child's development. Records are available for parents at any time. Children's WOW moments are documented on Tapestry which is an online learning journal that records your child's time at Nursery and their personal development.









Settling in Sessions

Starting at Nursery is a big step in a child's life and the way in which a child responds will vary. Some will feel at home immediately, whereas for others, it may take a little longer until they feel settled. We therefore encourage parents, carers and guardians to stay with their child, if necessary, until they feel confident in their new environment. We will always work with you, should you have any concerns in this area. We will offer your child a free settling in session of 1 hour. If you feel that your child would benefit from an additional session, please discuss this with a member of staff.



We encourage and support the children to initiate play and learning. The environment in Nursery is set to inspire and offer an invitation for the children to explore and learn. The children learn effectively through play.

At the start of each day, we have welcome time, which is a time for children to say hello and use their own photos for self-registration - acknowledging their time at Nursery. During welcome time, we complete some developmentally appropriate activities which can include phonics, maths activities, singing and stories. This time is also a time where children reflect and evaluate their day at Nursery and where we use children's ideas to evolve the setting.
